The successful candidate will be an excellent classroom practitioner. The position carries considerable responsibility: the heads of year and senior management work together as a team and are vital in maintaining the disciplined atmosphere and the strong learning ethos that prevails in the school. The successful candidate will be expected to play a leading role in ensuring that the progress made by individuals enables them to achieve their potential and gain access to top universities. We are also looking for a leader who has academic rigour and the sense of fun that is essential for motivating the students.
