The Grey Coat Hospital is seeking to recruit an outstanding teacher to lead the ICT department.

The school is situated in the heart of central London close to excellent transport links. We are a heavily oversubscribed Church of England multi-ethnic comprehensive school for girls with A*-C GCSE results regularly reaching 90% plus (85% including English and Mathematics). We also have a large sixth form of nearly 300 students where students also achieve outstanding results. Last year value-added analysis put us in the top 25% of schools in the country.

In March 2009 we were again identified as an '**outstanding school**' by Ofsted, the highest possible grade. We are very proud that they recognised the ethos of continual self-improvement which characterises every aspect of the school.

Applications are invited from enthusiastic, well-qualified and suitably skilled graduates to lead the ICT department. We are looking to appoint an individual who can continue the work of the current Head of Department in terms of raising attainment at KS3 and 4. ICT is also a popular option at KS4 and for the first time this September, the school will have two groups in Year 10. The Head of Department also leads on teaching one ICT lesson a fortnight through Modern Foreign Languages with two single linguist groups.

The Head of Department will be expected to play a pivotal role in the development of the VLE/LP which the school will launch next academic year. In addition the Head of Department will lead on setting up a training programme for staff focusing on ICT skills both in terms of classroom technologies and basic proficiency skills. Due to the increased whole school responsibility, the Head of Department will have a reduced teaching load.

As an Investor in People, the school has an excellent programme of support for all new staff and is committed to professional development. We actively encourage teachers to explore innovative approaches to teaching and learning.
