Students in Year 7 are expected to spend 20 minutes on each piece of homework.

Music: Homework in Music will be project work. Students will be expected to complete three main pieces of homework throughout the year; they are also encouraged to join a weekly music club to supplement their studies in their timetabled music lessons.

PE: Students are encouraged to attend one hour of an extra-curricular PE activity per week; students will also be set 20 minutes of PE homework per week.

ICT: The majority of ICT work is project-based computer work. Homework may be set during design and evaluation stages of these projects. All projects are assessed and contribute towards the students' ICT levels. Students may choose to work on their projects at home on a computer; it is, however, not 'set' homework. Students will have access to the computer rooms on a number of specified days after school to work on their ICT projects

Drama: The majority of drama work is practical and group-based. This will mean that there will only be occasional homework that will involve learning lines, completing scripts or finding costumes for example. Pupils will have drama once a fortnight and homework will be for next lesson so often they will have a full timetable rotation to do the work.
