Mobile Phone and Other Devices With Internet Access Policy

Both for educational and health and safety reasons we do not recommend that students bring mobile phones to school. If parents wish their daughters to carry a mobile phone it is only permitted on the understanding that it must be kept switched off and out of sight at all times. Mobile Phones and other devices with Internet access must not be seen, heard or used at any time whether inside or outside of the school buildings. This rule applies for during the school day and after school where a student is in school attending events or activities and clubs. Mobile phones that are seen or heard will be confiscated and held for 5 school days, after which students will be able to redeem them on payment of 50 pence. If you need to contact your daughter in case of emergency during the school day you can do so via the school office.

Handheld devices

(iPods, Kindles and Handheld devices) Years 7 to 11 students are not permitted to bring into school devices which have a messaging function or can be connected to the internet.
