The historic foundation of the school and its current ethos are rooted in a confident and generous Christian faith and practice, which welcomes students and staff of all backgrounds and beliefs.

Singing Teacher Part-time starting asap

Casual supply contract working term time only – 30 weeks per year.

We wish to appoint an experience and enthusiastic Singer Teacher to join our thriving music department and skilled team of 12 Peripatetic Teachers.

Students achieved 100% 4-9 at GCSE Music and 100% A to B grades at A level (based on our 2019 Music results). The instrumental/singing team are integral to our success, and as such we are looking for a candidate who can support the curriculum, up to A level standard.

Our teachers are highly regarded in the music world and perform regularly alongside their teaching.

ABOUT THE ROLE

The role will involve teaching students one-on-one in a range of styles. Candidates must have previous singing tuition experience and should be capable of teaching up to Grade 8 standard and beyond as well as GCSE and A Level performance. Piano skills are highly desirable.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- To provide high-quality individual singing tuition to allocated students
- To plan individual lessons that set challenging teaching and learning objectives which are relevant to the pupils taught
- To select and prepare resources including repertoire
- To monitor and assess pupil progress
- To organise and manage teaching and learning time effectively
- To maintain accurate attendance records
- To organise a timetable that adheres to the rota system in operation

HOURS

Initially 1/1.5 day teaching per week but with the opportunity to expand depending on student demand. The ideal candidate would be able to offer a reliable, consistent service

(regularity of teaching days) and provide 30 lessons throughout the year, split across 3 blocks of 10 lessons each as set by the school on a regular set day each week between 8am and 4pm. Although we require the teaching day to be set, some flexibility can be offered occasionally. The pay rate is currently £36 per hour which is paid via a monthly claim.

The school is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of young people and expects all members of staff to share this commitment. An enhanced DBS disclosure is required for all posts. Please note CVs will not be accepted.
