Year 9, 10 to end of Year 11: OCR 21st Century Science & Additional Science; small number of less able students will carry on with Single Science

Year 10/11: Two classes OCR 21st Century Triple Science

Year 12/13: OCR Chemistry A, Physics A, Biology A
