

To apply: All applicants MUST complete The Grey Coat Hospital Online Supplementary Form.

This is in addition to the CAF (Common Application Form).

Completing the **online** Supplementary Form

Step 1:

Step 2:

Complete the parent registration form.

Step 3:

You will receive a verification email from admin@applica.com where you will find a link to complete the Supplementary Form.

Step 4:

You will need to complete each section of the form **thoroughly** before you can move onto the next.

For church places only: If you are applying for a church place, please complete the clergy reference form that is available to download from The Grey Coat Hospital website. Please give the clergy form to your religious referee and ask them to send it to the school once complete. This should be addressed to **Admissions Team, The Grey Coat Hospital, Greycoat Place, London, SW1P 2DY.**

The clergy form is the same for both Church of England and Other Church applicants and it is *essential* when applying for a church place. If you are or have been involved with more than one Church, you may choose to submit multiple forms. Should you require a second reference, please print off a second blank clergy form.

Your child will not be considered for a Church place if we do not receive a clergy form from your selected referee, even if you have selected a Church place in the supplementary form. All components of the form must be completed for it to be considered.

For alternative entries: If you are applying under 1.7 (special circumstances) or as a Looked After Child, please upload evidence in the Support Information section of the online supplementary form. If you have more than one document, you will need to scan everything as a single item as there is a limit of one upload.

Important: All applicants will automatically be entered into the Open category. For applicants applying for a Church place, they will be considered under both categories.

Please make sure your online supplementary form AND your application via eAdmissions is completed by Saturday the 31st of October 2026.

LANGUAGE TEST INFORMATION

Test date: Tuesday 13 October 2026

Up to 15 (fifteen) places of the PAN (Published Admissions Number) will be offered to applicants solely on the strength of their aptitude for languages following the outcome of the Language Aptitude Test. The Language Aptitude Test Day is in the first half term of Year 6. It is in advance of the completion of the common application form and is on a different day to the banding assessment. The Language Test is for applicants who are applying for a Language place. No previous knowledge of a foreign language is expected or required. No other criteria for admission apply to these fifteen places.

The outcome of the test will be emailed to you by the end of October, before the close of applications.

BANDING TEST INFORMATION

Test date: Tuesday 8 December 2026

You should expect your daughter to be here for approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes. She should bring a pencil, rubber and ruler. Pens are not acceptable.

All applicants will be given a non-verbal reasoning test. Test results will be shared between St Marylebone School, St Augustine's and The Grey Coat Hospital, which means that if you apply to two or more of these schools, your child will only have to attend one of the tests.

We are unable to reschedule tests. If your child is unable to attend, you will need to supply a copy of her most recent primary school report, which will be available from her primary school by mid-December. If your child requires special conditions to complete the test, please contact the school in advance at lower-admissions@gch.org.uk.
